PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING. These Terms and Conditions are subject to change, amendment or update at any time during the Competition Period at the sole discretion of the Promoters. Any amendments will be published on the Gagasi FM website and will apply from the date of publication. Continued participation in the Competition following any amendment constitutes acceptance of the amended Terms and Conditions.

1. INTRODUCTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- 1.1** The “EEZEE WINS” Competition (“the Competition”) is brought to you by Eezee Noodles / Noodle King (“the Sponsor”) in partnership with Radio iGagasi 99.5FM (Pty) Ltd (“Gagasi FM”) (collectively “the Promoters”).
- 1.2** By entering the Competition and/or accepting any prize (if you are a winner), you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, as read together with Gagasi FM’s general competition terms and conditions referenced in clause 12.
- 1.3** The outcome of the Competition is subject to the decision of the judges, presenters and/or organisers of the Competition, whose decision is final and binding. No negotiations and/or correspondence will be entered into after the fact.
- 1.4** Participants enter into and take part in the Competition at their own risk. The Promoters bear no responsibility for any loss, damage or harm suffered as a result of participation in the Competition, save to the extent that such liability cannot be excluded in law.

2. COMPETITION PERIOD

- 2.1** The Competition commences at 00:00 on Wednesday, 15 July 2026 and closes at 23:59 on Friday, 11 September 2026 (“the Competition Period”).
- 2.2** The Competition will be promoted and played on the Gagasi FM Breakfast Show (06h00 – 09h00).
- 2.3** Any entries received after the close of the Competition Period will not be eligible, regardless of the reason for the late entry.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1** The Competition is open to natural persons who are 18 (eighteen) years or older at the time of entry and who are in possession of a valid South African Identity Document.
- 3.2** You will be disqualified if:
 - 3.2.1** you are under the age of 18 (eighteen) at the time of entering the Competition;
 - 3.2.2** you have won a competition conducted by Radio iGagasi 99.5FM (Pty) Ltd in the past 3 (three) months; or
 - 3.2.3** you are a director, employee, agent or consultant of the Promoters, their advertising or promotional agencies, or an immediate family member of any such person.
- 3.3** To be eligible to participate in the Grand Finale Challenge and claim the Grand Prize, entrants must be in possession of a valid South African Identity Document and a valid South African driver’s licence. Failure to provide proof of a valid driver’s licence upon request will result in disqualification.

4. HOW TO ENTER

- 4.1** To enter, entrants must purchase any Eezee Noodles 5-pack and submit a clear photograph of their valid till slip, together with the keyword #EEZEE, via the “Message The Studio” tab on the Gagasi FM Website Win Page or the Gagasi FM App.
- 4.2** The till slip must clearly reflect the qualifying purchase, the store name and the date of purchase, which must fall within the Competition Period. Entrants must retain their original till slip as proof of purchase, which may be requested for verification.
- 4.3** No entries submitted by post, e-mail, telephone or any other channel will be accepted.
- 4.4** Entries that are incomplete, illegible, altered or that contain errors will be invalid.
- 4.5** Multiple entries are permitted, provided that each entry is supported by a separate qualifying purchase and valid till slip.
- 4.6** The Promoters are not liable for any technical failure, network, hardware or software malfunction that may result in an entry not being successfully submitted or received.

5. FINALIST SELECTION

- 5.1** All valid entries will be reviewed and verified between 14 July 2026 and 18 September 2026.
- 5.2** 5 (five) finalists will be selected from the valid entries and announced on air on 21 September 2026.
- 5.3** Three of the five finalists will be selected from the Gagasi FM website entries, and two of the five finalists will be selected from the Gagasi FM App entries.
- 5.4** Each finalist will receive a finalist prize of box of Eezee Noodles, each box will include ten Eezee noodles five pack bundles (10 × 5-pack bundles).
- 5.5** If a finalist cannot be contacted, is found to be ineligible, or fails to confirm availability for the Grand Finale within the timeframe stipulated by the Promoters, the Promoters reserve the right to select an alternative finalist.

6. GRAND FINALE CHALLENGE

- 6.1** The Grand Finale will take place on Saturday, 26 September 2026 at Umlazi Mega City Mall.
- 6.2** Round 1: Each of the 5 (five) finalists will be given 60 (sixty) seconds to load as many Eezee Noodles packs as possible into the Red 2026 GAC Emzoom vehicle.
- 6.3** The 3 (three) finalists who load the highest number of Eezee Noodles packs into the designated vehicle within the allocated time will proceed to the Final Round.
- 6.4** Final Round: The 3 (three) remaining finalists will each have the chance to select a vehicle key from a jar of keys. The finalist who selects the correct key that opens the vehicle will be declared the Grand Prize winner.
- 6.5** The finalist with highest number of noodles packs loaded in the vehicle, will draw the first key from the jar.
- 6.6** In the event of a tie in Round 1, the tied finalists will repeat the loading challenge, and the finalist(s) with the higher count in the tie-breaker will proceed.

- 6.6** Finalists must attend the Grand Finale in person. Failure to attend will result in disqualification and, at the Promoters' discretion, replacement by an alternative finalist.

7. GRAND PRIZE

- 7.1** The Grand Prize is 1 (one) motor vehicle with the below specifications:

Make & Model: GAC Emzoom

Colour: Red

Year: 2026

Condition: Used (The car has been previously driven by the client, in order to promote the competition).

Estimated Mileage: +-5000km

Value: R360 000

- 7.2** A runner-up cash prize pool of R60 000 will be awarded to the remaining finalists as follows, as determined by Eezee Noodles :

- 2nd Place: R20 000
- 3rd Place: R20 000
- 4th Place: R10 000
- 5th Place: R10 000

- 7.3** Cash prizes will only be paid to finalists who provide valid South African banking details together with proof of bank account confirmation. Payment will be made by electronic funds transfer only.

- 7.4** The Prize is not transferable to any other person and is not redeemable for cash. No substitution of the Prize will be permitted, save at the sole discretion of the Promoters (including where the specified model becomes unavailable, in which case a vehicle of equivalent or greater value may be substituted).

- 7.5** Vehicle handover will take place within 1 (one) month of the live giveaway event (26 September 2026), subject to the winner complying with all verification and documentation requirements.

- 7.6** Once the vehicle handover date has been agreed upon, the vehicle handover will take place at the Noodle king factory. Located at 02 Richard Carte Rd, Mobeni, Durban.

8. VEHICLE CONDITIONS AND WINNER OBLIGATIONS

- 8.1** The winner will be liable to retain the Vehicle for a minimum period of 1 (one) year, during which the Vehicle will carry Noodle King branding. The branding may be subject to change or refresh 2 (two) to 3 (three) times per year at the Sponsor's cost and arrangement.

- 8.2** At the end of the minimum one-year period, the Sponsor will remove the branding at the sponsor's cost and arrangement. The sponsor is also liable for the cost of obtaining the Certificate of Roadworthiness and to handover the vehicle to the winner in a suitable state.

- 8.3** The winner is responsible, at the winner's own cost, for all running and ownership costs of the Vehicle, including but not limited to licensing and registration, insurance, maintenance, repairs, fuel, tracking devices and tyres. These costs will NOT be covered by Noodle King or Gagasi FM.

- 8.4** The winner is responsible for their own transportation to attend the finale and the collection of the vehicle, Located at 02 Richard Carte Rd, Mobeni, Durban.
- 8.4** Noodle King and Gagasi FM are not liable for insuring the Vehicle, nor for any damage to, or loss of, the Vehicle after handover, including without limitation theft, vandalism, accident damage or mechanical failure.
- 8.5** The winner is strongly advised to obtain comprehensive insurance for the Vehicle prior to or immediately upon handover. Ownership risk in the Vehicle passes to the winner on handover.
- 8.6** The winner may not sell, transfer or otherwise dispose of the Vehicle during the minimum retention period referred to in clause 8.1 without the prior written consent of the Sponsor.

9. WINNER VERIFICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

- 9.1** Winners must provide Gagasi FM with a copy of their bar-coded / smart card South African Identity Document and bank account confirmation, submitted to the station via e-mail, before any prize will be released.
- 9.2** The Promoters reserve the right to verify the validity of all entries, till slips, identity documents and driver's licences. Failure to satisfy verification requirements will result in disqualification and forfeiture of any prize.
- 9.3** The Promoters reserve the right to disqualify any entrant suspected of fraud or cheating, including without limitation through the manipulation of codes, submission of falsified till slips, or otherwise falsifying data.

10. PUBLICITY, PERSONAL INFORMATION AND POPIA

- 10.1** Personal information collected in connection with the Competition will be processed in accordance with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 ("POPIA") and will be used solely for purposes of administering the Competition, verifying entries, and awarding prizes, unless the entrant consents otherwise.
- 10.2** Finalists and winners may be requested to participate in reasonable publicity, including photographs, video, on-air interviews and social media content relating to the Competition. Winners are entitled to decline such publicity; declining will not affect their entitlement to a prize, save where attendance at the live Grand Finale event is a competition requirement under clause 6.6.
- 10.3** By entering, entrants consent to the Promoters contacting them via the contact details provided for purposes of the Competition.

11. GENERAL

- 11.1** The judges' decision in respect of all aspects of the Competition, including finalist selection and the Grand Prize winner, is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 11.2** The entire Competition will be managed, directed and audited by the Gagasi FM radio and legal team.
- 11.3** The Promoters reserve the right to suspend, extend, terminate or amend the Competition, the prizes and/or these Terms and Conditions at any time, for any reason, including where required by law or by circumstances beyond the Promoters' reasonable control. In such event, no entrant shall have any claim against the Promoters.

- 11.4** To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Promoters, their directors, employees and agents shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental or consequential loss or damage arising from participation in the Competition or the use of any prize.
- 11.5** Where required, the Competition will be conducted in accordance with the Consumer Protection Act 68 of 2008 as it relates to promotional competitions.
- 11.6** These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of the Republic of South Africa.
- 11.7** If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
